Homelessness	We have recently secured generous donations from community partnerships, allowing us to establish a food pantry to assist families facing economic challenges. Our food pantry will provide essential staples like rice, milk, canned goods, and more as short-term relief until our Community Involvement Specialist can connect them to essential community services. In addition, some of our students are registered in the Project UPSTART program and we have a productive partnership with the Miami Beach Police which fosters community engagement through various events, including holiday toy gives ways.
Work Scheduling Conflict	In response to work scheduling constraints, we facilitate parent workshops and engagement activities with flexible timing options, including morning and afternoon sessions on various days. Presentation materials and resources are made available in both English and Spanish on our school website for convenient access. This academic year, we are introducing school tours, conducted in the morning and evening, twice a month, with online registration options for both current and prospective parents. Furthermore, our Parent Orientation was scheduled on a Saturday prior to school year commencement.
